## 1ST SUMMER IMMERSION PROGRAM

- 5-week immersion program in the Grand Canyon Region including community-building activities, field trips and service-learning projects hosted by the Grand Canyon Trust and its partners;
- · Housing, meals, and \$2,500 stipend provided.

## 1ST SUMMER RESEARCH EXPERIENCE

- 5-week collaborative conservation research project in the Grand Canyon region with other scholars during the second half of the summer;
- · Housing at NAU and \$2,500 stipend provided.

## 2ND SUMMER RESEARCH EXPERIENCE

- 8-week research project with a small group of DD conservation scholars on conservation topics located nationwide;
- \$5,000 stipend provided.

### WINTER WORKSHOPS

- Five-day expense-paid workshop each January during the DDCS@NAU program provides specialized conservation skills training in quantitative analysis, geographic information systems (GIS) and spatial modeling, and communications;
- · Opportunity for scholars, mentors, and program staff to reconnect during the winter.
